

# Sample Bequest Language

## Specific Gift Language

Naming The Franciscan Friars of the Atonement as a beneficiary of a specific amount from your estate is easy:

I give and devise to The Franciscan Friars of the Atonement, located in Garrison, NY, the sum of \$ \_\_\_\_\_ (or asset) to be used for its general support (*or* for the support of a specific fund or program).

## Contingent Gift Language

The Franciscan Friars of the Atonement or its affiliates can be named as a contingent beneficiary in your will or personal trust if one or more of your specific bequests cannot be fulfilled:
